Scope

The first Scandinavian Symposium on Chemometrics was held in 1989 in Lappeenranta, Finland. The 11th Scandinavian Symposium on Chemometrics (SSC11) was successfully held in Loen, Norway in 2009. Denmark is now the host of the 12th Scandinavian Symposium on Chemometrics (SSC12) held in the Nordic countries.

At this conference we will, of course, have a strong scientific focus and the programme will include contributed lectures, poster presentations and a vendor exhibition. We will invite speakers from adjacent scientific areas as well as young scientists to present their research.

The meeting and not least the venue is an ideal forum for networking and various activities will be arranged to facilitate this.

Venue

The Danish Chemometric Society welcomes participants from both academia and industry. The organisers encourage young researchers in particular to contribute.

The symposium language is English. The proceedings will be published in an international scientific journal.

Contributions

Participants are invited to present titles or subjects for oral or poster presentation on the Preliminary Registration form in order to facilitate the planning of the Symposium Programme.

oral presentations	approximately 20 minutes
poster presentations	approximately 0.8×1.2 m ²
demonstrations	anytime

Abstracts of 2-400 words must be forwarded electronically by mid January 2011. The format for abstract submission and the information required will be posted on www.ssc12.dk. Receipt of abstracts will be acknowledged, and acceptance will be communicated by April 2011. Full papers are due before the end of the symposium, and all papers will be peer reviewed before publication.
